Georgian Bay Forever is recruiting 300 volunteers in Collingwood to slow the flow of plastic from entering Georgian Bay.

Why? Fish have no idea they are eating microplastics. You probably don't either.

BE A SOLUTION TO PLASTIC POLLUTION

Plastic microfibres are tiny strands less than 5mm in size that get released from your synthetic clothes in the laundry and end up in our lakes and oceans. Studies show up to 700,000 microfibres can be shed from just one wash! We are seeing microplastics in higher concentrations in the Great Lakes than we are seeing in the oceans. A growing body of research indicates that there are negative effects to animal health from ingestion, effects on human health are unknown and studies are just starting. Microfibres are capable of containing and absorbing toxic chemicals from the surrounding environment. While WWTP are unsung heroes of water quality, they can capture up to 90% of microfibre pollution - meaning that millions/billions are escaping and accumulating in the water environment. **We need you!** GBF is looking for volunteers to install a free filter on their washing machine, and participate in the collection and measurement of the waste from their laundry.

DID YOU KNOW?


Humans consume about the size of a credit card of plastic every week!

Let's make a difference!

To qualify, 3 simple criteria must be met.

- 1. Volunteers must use their washing machine year round and be connected to Collingwood Town water.
- 2. There must be space for the filter unitwhich is about the size of a large vertical paper towel dispenser.
- 3. Georgian Bay Forever needs some volunteer participation over the course of 3 years, which included a short survey about laundry habits and emptying the filter every 2-3 weeks in a provided bag that will be picked up for measurement.
